Chinese Accounting Officials Study Texas University Management Practices

TIEC hosted a study mission from China's National Accounting Institute (NAI) on March 19-22, 2003, whose purpose was to observe and learn about the management structure of Texas higher education institutions, especially financial management; and to study various aspects of university administration, including student dormitory operations, campus security, food services, and health services.

The delegation was headed by Mr. Xiaochao Dong, NAI's Vice President, and Mr. Ning Wang, Vice-Secretary General of the Beijing Institute of Certified Public Accountants; other participants included Ms. Li Luo, Ms. Ying Zhang, Mr. Guodong Wang, and Ms. Qun Mao. Mr. Ocean Sun served as escort and interpreter.

In cooperation with the Office of the Associate Vice President for International Programs at The University of Texas at Austin, TIEC arranged for the group to tour several administrative complexes at the university and receive detailed briefings from Mr. Brian Gutierrez, Associate Vice President and Controller; Mr. Scott Meyer, Mr. Randy Porter, and Ms.
