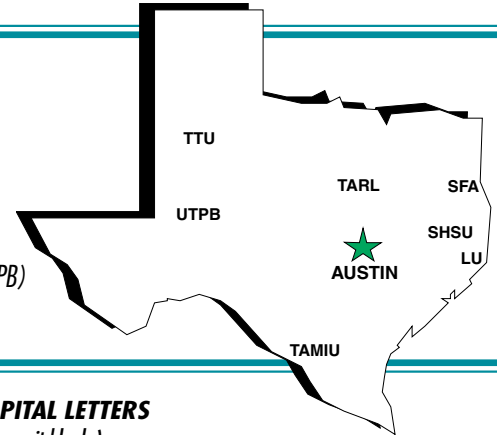
TIEP tuition and fees include TIEP classroom instruction, immigration counseling and documentation, orientation program, academic advising, ongoing counseling and support throughout the TIEC Study Abroad Program, placement testing, an Institutional TOEFL, computer lab, Internet and e-mail access, selected enrichment and social activities, photo ID card, and certificate.

TIEP tuition and fees do NOT include housing, meals, textbooks, medical insurance, or Texas university tuition and fees after study at TIEP. Medical insurance is required of all students.
