Tuition, Room, Meal (TRM) Package

TRM is a special summer program that allows a student to pay for tuition, fees, housing, and meals in one easy, convenient fee. It is offered in cooperation with the University Towers, a deluxe dormitory located only two blocks away from TIEP. Each four-bedroom suite is equipped with two bedrooms, one bath, living room, and kitchen. Students are allowed 19 meals per week in the cafeteria. A swimming pool, computer lab, exercise room, and laundry facilities are available on-site. All utilities are paid, including electricity, WiFi, cable TV, and weekly housekeeping.



To apply and reserve a space in the summer TRM package, send the TIEP application, TRM Resident Information and Preference Profile, and a non-refundable, non-transferable fee of \$230 (includes one-time \$95 TIEP application fee and \$135 TRM processing fee). Return all materials to TIEP prior to application deadline. Depending on availability, student can request a private room for an extra fee.

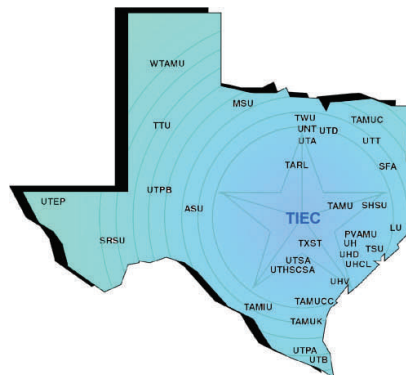
TIEC Members

TIEP is a division of the Texas International Education Consortium (TIEC), an association of 32 Texas institutions for international education. In cooperation with its affiliates, TIEP has arranged conditional admission with accredited colleges and universities. These schools have agreed to offer our students assured admission to an academic program upon meeting minimum English-language requirements. TIEP also has TOEFL waiver agreements with several Texas colleges and universities. These institutions have agreed to waive the TOEFL score requirement for advanced-level students who successfully complete TIEP's English for Academic Purposes program. To be eligible for either service, a student must enroll and study at TIEP for a minimum of eight weeks. For full admission, a student must meet minimum application requirements such as GPA, standardized test scores, prerequisite courses, or essays.
